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ONLINE IBAC MEETING.

Date : 30th August, 2020

Time : 11 a.m. to 12 noon.

Platform : Google Meet.

Present : IBAC members and all full time teachers.

CHAIR : Dr. P. K. Roy Principal took the chair.

Meeting Link : Google Meet link was shared by the IBAC coordinator with all full time teachers and IBAC members by sending the link to WhatsApp groups :

- ii) JCC IBAC.

Discussion on holding online classes : The coordinator explained the backdrop of this meeting. He mentioned that on 11th March 2020, the COVID-19 outbreak was declared a global pandemic by the W.H.O. On 24th March 2020 the Indian government announced a strict 21-day lockdown followed by further extensions. He also mentioned that the pursuant to C.U. notification dated 16-03-20 and declaration of ^{the} Honorable Chief Minister, West Bengal as well as communication of the Principal Secretary, West Bengal dt 17/03/20 the normal working of the college has been suspended with immediate effect. He further mentioned that normal physical classes for students having been suspended as a result the IBAC and college has taken steps to resume classes by using ICT help of Google Meet Platform and ^{the college website} effective from 21st August 20. And, now that it

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being an absolutely new method of imparting learning to students, need has, therefore, arisen to discuss the issues the teachers or students are facing.

The members exchanged views on various issues they thought appropriate to discuss.

On a question raised by G.B. members, Dr. Saibal Chakraborty, the coordinator answered to his satisfaction that the online classes are smoothly going on and the students are coping with the new technology based teaching/learning quite satisfactorily.

On a question raised by a member, Prof. D. Bhattacharya replied that though from teachers side not any mentionable problem is noticed but on student side the problem of digital divide is there to some extent which is mainly, due to economic condition of the concerned students who are failing to afford the cost of digital equipment and internet. He, however, mentioned that efforts are being made to solve the problem as far as possible.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
